As per the Government Order read 1st paper above, orders have been issued, fixing the norms for the selection of NCC cadets for admission to Professional Degree Courses including Polytechnic and B.Sc Nursing. As per the Government Order read 2nd paper above, Government have added General Nursing & Midwifery and ITI courses along with Professional Courses such as Engineering, Medicine, Polytechnic and B.Sc Nursing in the norms for selection of NCC Cadets.

2. As per the Government Order read 3rd paper above, Government have approved the prospectus for admission to 5 year LLB Course, wherein special reservation for NCC cadets in Government Law Colleges and Self Financing Law Colleges have also been included. Accordingly the Additional Director General, NCC has suggested certain modifications to the prevalent norms for the Selection of NCC Cadets for admission to various courses.
