ORDER

Little Flower College, Guruvayoor was granted permission to conduct B Voc courses in Pharmaceutical Chemistry (50 seats) and Tourism and Hospitality Management (50 Seats) with the assistance of University Grants Commission in the financial year 2014-15. Now the Management of the College has requested to grant NoC to run the said courses in Self Financing Stream.

Government examined the case in detail and are pleased to renew the NOC issued for continuing B Voc courses in Pharmaceutical Chemistry (50 seats) and Tourism and Hospitality Management (50 Seats) courses in Self financing stream in Little Flower College, Guruvayoor, Thrissur for the academic year 2017-18 subject to the following conditions.

1. The Management of the College shall submit documents to prove that the College has adequate infrastructure, human and physical to conduct the course as required by the Government.
2. The Management shall abide by the procedure of admission in the college as decided by the Government from time to time.
3. The Management shall set apart 50% of the seats of the course for being filled up by the Government or such authority determined by Government on the basis of merit and reservation principles followed by the Government and the remaining 50% filled by the Management on the basis of merit.
4. The Management shall collect only such fees as determined by the Government from time to time from the students admitted to the college for the course.
5. The Management shall institute adequate number of scholarships on merit cum means basis as determined by the Government from time to time to the students admitted to the course.
6. The Management shall appoint and fix the service conditions of the teachers and non teaching staff in the college for conducting the course as followed by Government in conducting similar courses.
7. The Educational Agency shall institute an appropriate governance structure that would ensure transparency, efficiency and social accountability in the Educational agency as determined by the Government from time to time.
8. The Management shall publish the details regarding the establishment and governance of Management, admission, fees, courses, results, teaching and other staff, and any further information as required by the Government on the website of the Management.
9. The Management shall run only courses approved by the Government and the University concerned.
- 10.The Management shall enable the Government and its representatives to check, verify and monitor the compliance of the conditions mentioned above at any time the Government so decides.

- Management shall enter into an agreement with the affiliating University on the terms determined by the affiliating University in respect of all or any of the matters contained in this agreement.
12. In the event of breach of any of the conditions mentioned above by the Management, the Government is authorized to adjudicate the quantum of compensation which the Educational agency is liable to pay to the Government, if any, and upon such adjudication, the Educational Agency shall pay to Government the amount so fixed, failing which the amount of compensation adjudicated should be recoverable under the provision of Kerala Revenue Recovery Act, 1968, as if they were public revenue due on land.
 13. The No Objection Certificate/ sanction granted shall be valid up to the end of the Academic year 2017-18 and renewable on the request of the Management and subject to the satisfactory compliance of the conditions specified herein.
 14. In the event of the breach of any of the conditions mentioned above by the educational agency, the Government shall also be entitled to withdraw the sanction without formal notice to the Educational Agency.
 15. The Management shall produce necessary documents for the continued affiliation from the University for the year 2017-18 before 15.02.2018 failing which the sanction issued will be treated as cancelled, w.e.f 15.02.2018 and the Government will not be responsible for any loss incurred by the institution and the institution shall be solely responsible for the losses thereof.
 16. The Management of the College has to remit necessary fee for renewal of NoC and produce chalan thereof and also the affidavit to be executed with the Government within a fortnight.
