It has been clarified, among other things, in the G.O read as first paper above that the teachers who have been appointed after 13.3.90 should have obtained 55% marks in P.G. Course of the concerned subject.

2) In the letter read as 2nd paper above, the UGC has now pointed out that where the selection/appointment are made through duly constituted committees to the post of lecturers prior to 19.9.91 are exempted from 55% marks in P.G level. In the circumstances Government are pleased to further clarify that the teachers selected/appointed through duly constituted bodies/Committees to the post of lecturers prior to 19.9.91 are exempted from 55% marks in P.G. level.
