O R D E R

In the G.O. read as first paper above, orders were issued that the UGC Scheme including revision of scale of pay to the teachers of affiliated colleges will be implemented w.e.f. 1-1-1986 and that the retirement age will continue as at present. As per para 7.01 of UGC Scheme appended to the G.O. read as 3rd paper above, the teachers in affiliated colleges will retire at the age of 55 and thereafter no extension of service should be given.

2. In the G.O. read as 4th paper above, it was also ordered that the teachers in private colleges who have opted for retirement at the age of 60 years under Chapter III of the University Statutes and who have not yet attained the age of 55 will be given a chance to re-opt to retire at the age of 55, if they so desire to avail themselves of the benefit of UGC Scheme/Scale of pay. Eventhough the retirement age of the teachers of KKTM College, Pullut, is 60 they will not come under this category.

3. The Anomaly Redressal Committee on the implementation of UGC Scheme at the meeting held on 6-2-1992 has discussed the issue of the teachers of KKTM College, Pullut and recommended that they may also be allowed to opt to retire at the age of 55 years under the same conditions as stipulated in G.O. read as 4th paper above so that the benefit of the UGC Scheme can be extended to them also. Regarding work load, the College has to be taken as a separate unit and the work load from 1-1-1986 onwards to be considered for identification of posts coming under the UGC Scheme. Then the Staff appointed

by the previous management may be brought under the Scheme and only when such person are not available, Government College teachers are to be brought under the Scheme on the basis of the common seniority.

4. Government have examined the matter in detail and order that the teachers of K.K.T.M. College, Pullut, will be allowed to opt to retire at the age of 55 years, under the same conditions as stipulated in G.O. read as 4th paper above. The question of fixing the work load and seniority will be examined and orders issued separately.
