O R D E R

In the G.O. read as 2nd paper above, Government had constituted a Screening/Selection Committee for placement of Private/Government College teachers as required in the G.O. 1st cited. The Hon.High Court of Kerala in their judgement dated 8-8-97 in O.P.No.8881/96 squashed the Government Order 2nd cited and declared the constitution of the Screening Committee for Private College teachers as illegal and arbitrary. Consequent on this placements already ordered by the Screening Committee became null and void.

2. Government as per G.O. 3rd cited have taken the following decisions:

- (1) The placements already granted to the teachers prior to 31-1-94 will not be reopened. Such placements will be treated as regularised.
- (2) All teachers will be given extension of time till 31-3-2001 for undergoing the required number of refresher courses.
- (3) The stipulations regarding refresher course will not be a bar for placements for the following category of teachers:
 - (a) Those who have already retired from service.
 - (b) Those who are due to retirement before 31-3-2001.
 - (c) Those who have already expired.

- (4) Effect of placements will be from the date due and not from the date of completion of requisite number of refresher courses.
- (5) The placement orders issued to teachers (Private and Government) based on the decision of the earlier screening committee shall be treated as regularised.
3. The Private College teachers have now represented that the above G.O. is silent on payment of salary of private college teachers whose placements were ordered by the concerned managements and approval given by the concerned Universities.
4. Government have examined the case in detail and are pleased to order that the private college teachers who are otherwise eligible for promotion/placements from 1-1-1986 will be given promotions/placements provisionally without screening on the condition that they should undergo screening as and when the Screening/Selection Committee is constituted as per the stipulation in 1986 University Grants Commission Scheme. Arrears of salary on this will be credited to the PF account of the concerned individuals.
