O R D E R

In the G.O. read as 5th paper above, all existing Assistant Librarians Grade II and above in the Universities and Librarian Grade I and above in Private Colleges affiliated to the Universities who were in service on or before 1.1.1986 and who possess the qualifications prescribed by the concerned universities in Kerala and by Government in G.O.(P)No.36/71/Edn. dated 23.8.1971 and amendments issued thereunder, will be brought under the UGC Scheme in relaxation of qualifications prescribed by the UGC.

2. As per the G.O. read as 6th paper above, the Librarians who are eligible to come under the UGC. Scheme as per G.O. read as 5th paper above, a maximum period of two years service in the Library Service in posts equal to or higher than that of Junior Lecturer will be considered for placement in the higher scale.

3. The Anomaly Redressal Committee on the implementation of UGC Scheme at the meeting held on 9.11.1991 has discussed the issue of Librarians who were in service on or before 1.1.90 for inclusion ~~in~~ in the UGC Scheme, in detail. The Committee recommended that the period of relaxation in qualification envisaged in the G.O. read as 5th paper above may be extended up to 31.3.1990, provided they undergo refresher/orientation courses for acquiring qualification for higher academic excellence as contemplated in the UGC Scheme.

4. Government have examined the matter in detail and order that the period of relaxation from the UGC qualification given as per the G.O. 5th ^{paper} read above in the case of Librarians referred to above will be extended up to 31.3.1990, provided they undergo refresher/orientation course for acquiring qualifications for higher academic excellence as contemplated in the UGC Scheme with the additional condition that in such cases the salary benefit under UGC scales will accrue only from 1.4.1990 as and when they complete eight year's service as has been allowed in the case of college teachers.


