O R D E R

As per the Government Orders read as 1st, 2nd and 3rd paper above, Government have introduced the U.G.C. Scheme and scales in the State. The Scheme is not applicable to those posts intended for teaching at the Pre-Degree level. In the Government Order dated 23.3.1990 read above, Government have inter-alia ordered that those who will be appointed in vacancies relating to Pre-Degree classes after the issue of this order will be eligible to take classes for Pre-Degree Course only in future and they will not be eligible to take classes for Degree courses. It was also ordered that their qualifications, method of appointment etc will be decided by Government.

At the time of introducing U.G.C. Scheme in the State, the College teachers in service were bifurcated as 52% coming under the U.G.C. Scheme who are required for teaching at Degree/P.G. level and 48% not coming under the scheme ie College teachers required for teaching at Pre-Degree level. When teachers coming under the 48% category are considered and absorbed against vacancies occurring in higher posts in the scheme ie 52% category, the resultant vacancies required for teaching to the Pre-Degree classes could not be filled up as qualification and method of appointment etc for Pre-Degree teachers have not been prescribed. The Director of Collegiate Education has reported that there are a number of vacancies of teachers required for teaching Pre-Degree course. He has therefore suggested that a new cadre of teachers for teaching the Pre-Degree course may be created and their qualification and method of appointment may be prescribed as already ordered in the Government Order 2nd read above.

Government have considered the proposal of Director of Collegiate Education and the prevailing circumstances and are pleased to order; the creation of a new cadre of teachers in the Collegiate Education subordinate service for teaching Pre-Degree courses in the State with the following qualifications, method of appointment, etc.

- 1) The designation of the new category of teachers shall be "Junior Lecturer (Pre-Degree)".
- 2) The method of appointment shall be;
 - 1) By appointment from among High School Assistants in the General Education Department.
 - 11) In the absence of qualified hands for appointment in item (i) above, by direct recruitment.
- 3) The qualification regarding age;
 - 1) For appointment under item 2 (i) above there shall be no age limit.
 - 11) No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment if he has not completed 22 years of age or is above 35 years of age on the 1st day of January of the year in which the applications for appointment are invited. Usual relaxation in upper age limit shall be allowed to candidates belonging to SC/STs and other backward classes.
- 4) Other qualifications;
 - 1) Masters Degree in the concerned subject with at least 50% marks or its equivalent.
 - 11) B.Ed. Degree.

Note:- When qualifications being equal preference will be given to candidates who possess adequate knowledge in Malayalam.

- 5) The scale of pay of the post of Junior Lecturer (Pre-Degree) will be Rs.2060-3200.

The Director of Collegiate Education will initiate steps to appointment candidates against the existing vacancy. The recruits shall be made to submit a signed statement before joining service that they will not make any claim for absorption as lecturers of Colleges for obtaining U.C.C. benefits in future.
