O R D E R

In the G.O. read as 4th paper above, Government had constituted a Screening/Selection Committee for placement of private/Government college teachers as required in the G.O. read as 2nd paper above. The Hon'ble High Court in their judgment dated 8-8-97 in O.P.No.8881/96 quashed the Government Order 4th cited and declared the constitution of the Screening Committee for private college teachers as illegal and arbitrary. Consequent on this the placements already ordered by the Screening Committee became null and void. Government have received several representations from the recognised teachers organisations regarding the difficulties in undergoing the requisite number of refresher courses within the stipulated period prescribed in the Government Order read as 2nd paper cited. As per the recent regulation of the University Grants Commission dated 24-12-98 the University Grants Commission has extended the time limit for undergoing the requisite number of refresher courses.

Government have examined in detail the various issues connected with the judgment of the Hon'ble High Court in O.P. No.8881/96 and the requests made by the teachers organisations and are pleased to order as follows:

- (1) The placements already granted to the teachers prior to 31-1-94 will not be reopened. Such placements will be treated as regularised.

- (2) All teachers will be given extension of time till 31-3-2001 for undergoing the required number of refresher courses.
- (3) The stipulations regarding refresher course will not be a bar for placements for the following category of teachers.
 - (a) Those who have already retired from service.
 - (b) Those who are due to retirement before 31-3-2001.
 - (c) Those who have already expired.
- (4) Effect of placements will be from the date due and not from the date of completion of requisite number of refresher courses.
- (5) The placement orders issued to teachers (Private and Government) based on the decision of the earlier Screening Committee (Committee constituted as per G.O.(MS)No.15/94/H.Edn. dated 31-1-94) shall be treated as regularised.


