O R D E R

In the G.O. read as 1st paper above, Government have issued orders implementing UGC Scheme including revision of scales of pay to teachers in affiliated Colleges and UGC Scale of Pay to the other category of teachers not covered by the Scheme.

2. In the G.O. read as 2nd above Government issued orders among other things that the College teachers in service will be bifurcated as 52% as coming under the UGC Scheme and 48% as not coming under the Scheme.

3. In the G.O. read as 3rd paper above, it was ordered that the UGC Scheme will be made applicable to the qualified Physical Education Teachers also along with others. It was also clarified that the fixation of the number of posts of Physical Education Teachers under UGC Scheme will be made only on the basis of student strength for degree and post-graduate classes in each College. The student strength in Pre-degree classes will not be taken into account for this. Orders fixing the number of posts of Physical Education Teachers under UGC Scheme on the basis of student strength will be issued separately.

4. In the meanwhile Government as per letter read as 5th paper above as an interim measure have directed that one Physical Education Teacher in each College where the number of students under Degree/P.G. Course is 1000 or below will be brought under the UGC Scheme. All other Physical Education

Teachers who are not eligible to come under the UGC Scheme will be granted UGC scales on completion of 8 years service as specified in the Scheme.

5. Now Government order that applying the same principle in the G.O. read as 2nd paper above the Physical Education Teachers in the Government Colleges/Aided Colleges will be bifurcated as 52% coming under the UGC Scheme and 48% as not coming under the Scheme. Accordingly the existing teachers in Physical Education will be brought under UGC Scheme subject to the condition that there will be one post under UGC Scheme in each College where there are degree and P.G.

6. All other Physical Education Teachers who are not eligible to come under the UGC Scheme will be granted UGC Scales on completion of 8 years of service as specified in the Scheme, but without any back arrears.
