O R D E R

In the G.O. read as 1st paper above, Government issued orders implementing UGC Scheme including revision of scales of pay to teachers in affiliated colleges and UGC scale of pay to the other category of teachers not covered by the scheme.

2. In the minutes read as IInd paper above, the Anomaly-Redressal Committee on the implementation of UGC Scheme at its meeting held on 25.9.91 discussed the issue of placement of teachers in Syriac, Latin, Arabic etc for inclusion in the UGC Scheme, in detail. Committee is of the view that in the case of teachers appointed before 1.1.86 in all other subjects, the qualifications prescribed by Universities concerned in their regulations at the time of their appointment are accepted, ~~are~~ ^{as} sufficient for inclusion under the Scheme. Likewise the teachers in Syriac, Latin, Arabic etc can be brought under the scheme if they are qualified according to University norms, then in force. Hence committee decided to move Government with the above recommendation for issuing necessary orders.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail. The minimum qualification for appointment as Lecturer under the UGC Scheme is Master's Degree in the subjects with 55% marks. But as per the University regulation then in force it can be seen that Diploma and Bachelors Degree respectively were prescribed as the minimum qualification for teachers of Syriac and Latin. In this circumstance Government are pleased to order that the teachers in Syriac, Latin and Arabic etc who got appointment prior to 1.1.86 and continuing in service as on 13.3.90 are temporarily exempted from having qualification prescribed by the UGC. (Government are also pleased to order)

that they will be brought under the UGC Scheme and placement given if they are having the qualification prescribed earlier in the university statutes on condition that they should acquire the qualification prescribed by UGC within a period of two years.


